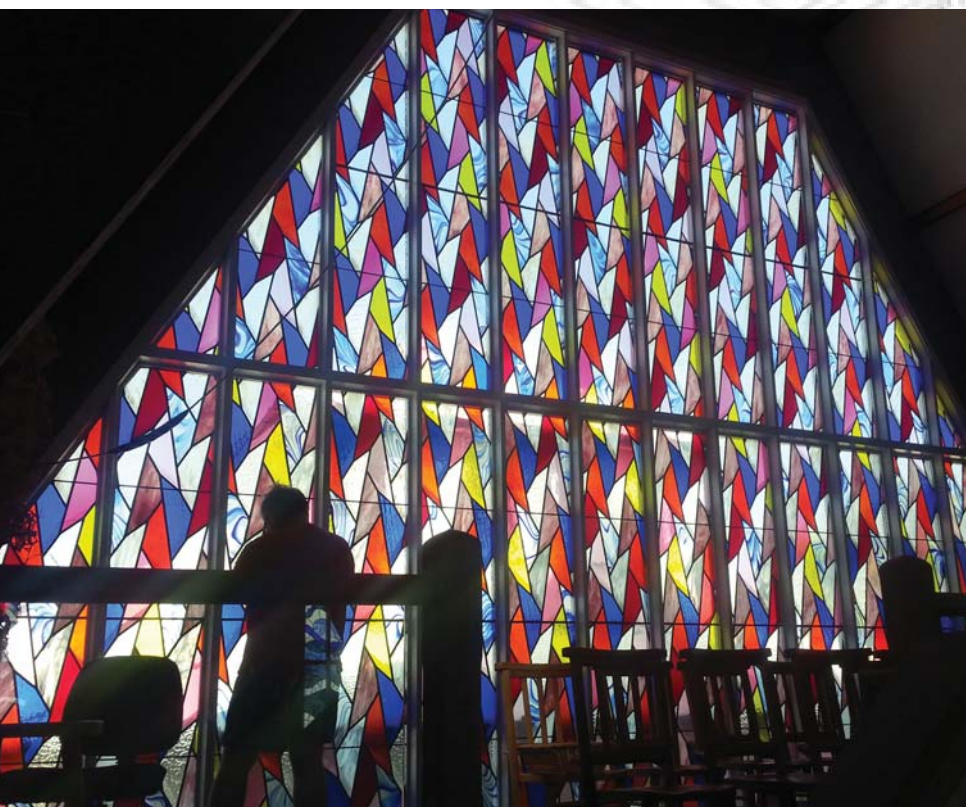
THE WAY WE WORK...
